SCHOOL MEALS – PRICE INCREASE

The Education Authority recently set out a number of measures in response to a significant shortfall of around £300 million. As part of these measures school meal prices will increase in January for the first time since 2017. Pupils entitled to free school meals will not be affected by this rise and will continue to receive a meal as before.

The price of a school meal will rise from £2.60 to £3.10 per day from January 2026.

Term 2 school meals will commence with **WEEK 1 on Monday 5 January 2026**. Please note that due to the whole school trip to the pantomime all pupils will require a **packed lunch** on **Friday 9 January 2026**.
