Dear parent,

I would like to remind parents of pupils on the school's SEN register to complete the google form linked below. This is an opportunity for you to provide feedback to the school. As we are approaching mid-term, I would like to wish all our families and pupils an enjoyable break.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

'If a child of compulsory school age is registered at a school it is essential that they attend their school regularly and maintain a pattern of good attendance throughout their school career. Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a child or young person to fulfil their potential.' *DENI Attendance Matters a Parents' Guide*.

The school expects individual attendance of at least 95% and an overall school attendance of 97%+ over the academic year. Overall school attendance is currently **92.6%** and many of our pupils' attendance has fallen below **90%.** Having myself been unwell on three occasions this year I am aware that there are often illnesses, weather conditions and other mitigating circumstances which may lead to low levels of attendance.

Following a period of absence it is a parent's responsibility to provide a written explanation of the absence to your child/ren's class teacher. Telephone calls and Seesaw messages will not suffice. As the weather improves and the number of bugs and viruses circulating amongst the pupils reduces, I would hope to see a continuing improvement to the attendance percentages for individual pupils and for the whole school.

I have included the attendance table below to highlight again the link between low attendance and the number of days lost.
